





- (ii) <u>Kinnerton Lane</u>, <u>Higher Kinnerton</u> from its junction with Main Road for a distance of 258 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- (iii) <u>Sandy Lane, Higher Kinnerton from its junction with Main Road for a distance of 235 metres in a southerly direction.</u>
- (iv) <u>Sandy Lane, Higher Kinnerton from a point 368 metres south of its junction</u> with Main Road for a distance of 152 metres in a southerly direction.
- (v) The Green, Higher Kinnerton from its junction with Sandy Lane for a distance of 100 metres in a south-easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 2 40 MPH Speed Limit

(i) Main Road, Higher Kinnerton from a point 436 metres from its junction with Kinnerton Lane for a distance of 545 metres in a north easterly direction (to the National/County Boundary).
