## Mandatory declarations about the information you have provided and the application process

## Declarations must be completed by or on behalf of ALL applicants

I understand that I must promptly inform my local authority of any changes that may affect my entitlement to a badge.	
I confirm that the photograph I have submitted with my application is a true likeness.	
I understand that, if my application is successful, I must not allow any other person to use the badge for their benefit and that I must only use the badge in accordance with the rules of the scheme as set out in "The Blue Badge Scheme - Rights and Responsibilities in Wales" leaflet which will be sent to me with the badge. <b>Fraudulent applications or misuse of a badge may result in a fine of £1,000 and/or forfeit of the badge.</b>	
I understand that I must not hold more than one valid Blue Badge at any time.	
I understand that I will return my previous badge once it has expired.	
I confirm that I do not currently hold a Blue Disabled Person's Parking Badge that has been issued by a different local authority.	
I understand a charge of £10 will be applicable if the badge is lost, stolen or damaged to the extent it cannot be read by people who will be checking the badge when used for parking or other concessions.	
I understand that the Council will confirm my address by checking other Council records including Council Tax, Electoral Register and School Records.	
I understand that the Local Authority may ask me to supply further information in order to make the decision to proceed to an assessment of my application.

## Privacy notice:

Your data will be processed by Flintshire County Council for the purposes of assessing eligibility and provision of a Blue Badge as per the 'Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000'. Flintshire County Council may share your data with other Local Authorities, Police, Parking Enforcement and approved Occupational Therapy Services contracted by Welsh Government for the purposes of assessment.

Successful applicant's information will be retained by Flintshire County Council for a period of three years after death or cessation of the service. ## BLUE BADGE – AUTOMATIC APPLICATION EVIDENCE

- Proof of ID (Passport, Driving Licence, Birth Certificate and Marriage Certificate)
- Proof of Address (Council Tax Bill, Benefits letter, Driving Licence)
- A passport style photo (this can be taken free of charge at our Connects Offices)

### Proof of eligibility

- An Ophthalmologist Report CV1/BD8 form confirming the applicant is 'severely sight impaired (Blind)'. Registration with the local authority as Sight Impaired at the 'severe' level.
- Higher Rate of the Mobility Component of Disability Living Allowance **dated within the last 12 months**
- Receive Personal Independence Payment (PIP) Mobility 8 Points or more, Journey Planning 12 Points. **Original letter showing points and uprating letter dated within the last 12 months**
- War Pensioner's Mobility Supplement
- Qualifying award under the Armed Forces and Reserve Forces (Compensation) Scheme
