STATEMENT OF POLICY

MARKETS POLICY

'TO PROMOTE AND PROTECT THE COUNCIL'S MARKET FRANCHISES IN SUCH A WAY AS TO SUPPORT THE ECONOMIC VIABILITY OF TOWN CENTRES IN FLINTSHIRE, ASSIST CHARITY MARKETS AND PREVENT MARKET OPERATIONS CAUSING PUBLIC COMPLAINT.'

CONDITIONS

- 1 These conditions will apply to all occasional markets, fairs, antique, craft and other similar markets within six and two-thirds miles of Flintshire County Council's markets and situated within the area of the County.
- 2 The right to operate markets is vested in the County Council and no individual company, charity or other organisation may operate such within the County of Flintshire without the permission of the Council. The types of event referred to in paragraph 1 that involve the setting up of a "concourse of buyers and sellers" and the letting of space, stalls or pitches falls within the description of markets or fairs and will be subject to these conditions.
- 3 If a market, fair or car boot sale etc is held by permission of the Council, an acknowledgement fee of £2.00 for each stall, pitch or car is payable (i.e. in respect of each eight foot or part thereof), up to 35 stalls, pitches or cars subject to a minimum charge of £90.66 in respect of each market, fair or car boot sale etc., unless an alternative fee has been levied.
- 4 Markets outside the County boundary should be the subject of application to the appropriate County Council, but Flintshire County Council reserves the right to object to, and claim protection against, such markets within six and two-thirds miles under Common Law.
- 5 Not less than twenty-eight days notice must be given to the Council prior to the intention to hold a market, fair or car boot sale etc.
