Mae Barnardo's wedi derbyn cyllid o'r Gronfa Gyfamod i gyflwyno gwasanaeth i deuluoedd a phlant Cyn-filwyr sydd angen cefnogaeth. Rydym ni'n dymuno gweithio'n gydweithredol gydag Elusennau Milwyr drwy Gymru er mwyn sicrhau ein bod yn mabwysiadu dull cydgysylltiedig, ac yn sefydlu partneriaethau cryf er mwyn cwrdd ag anghenion cyn-filwyr a'u teuluoedd s'n gorgyffwrdd.

Gwasanaeth ymyriad cynnar yw GCTC lle mae ein ffocws pennaf ar y plant a theulu'r cyn-filwr. Mae'r gwasanaeth yn anelu at alluogi teuluoedd i ddatblygu strategaethau ymarferol a defnyddiol i ymateb i'r problemau a'r anawsterau y maen nhw'n eu hwynebu, ac yn eu cefnogi nhw i wneud y newidiadau yr hofffen nhw eu gwneud.

Meini Prawf y Gwasanaeth

- 1) Teuluoedd Cyn-filwyr yn eu cymuned leol, sy'n cael anawsterau ac yn gofyn am gymorth
- 2) Plant a theuluoedd cyn-filwyr sy'n cael/neu mewn perygl o gael eu heffeithio gan y system Cyfiawnder Troseddol.

Meini Prawf Cymhwysedd

Teulu cyn-filwr, lle mae gan y plentyn a/neu riant anghenion cymorth lluosog.

Mae angen i'r plentyn fod o dan 18 oed ac yn byw yng Nghymru.

Plentyn a/neu riant/gofalwr sy'n cael ei effeithio oherwydd bod y cyn-filwr yn ymwneud â'r system cyfiawnder troseddol a all gynnwys:

- Bod mewn perygl o ymddygiad troseddol
- Wedi cael ei arestio, ei gyhuddo neu'i euogfarnu o drosedd
- yn gwneud eu tymor mewn carchar

Sut a beth yr ydym ni'n ei wneud

Mae'r cymorth sy'n cael ei ddarparu yn unigryw i bob teulu, ac yn seiliedig ar asesiad o'u hanghenion unigol.

Rydym ni'n defnyddio amrywiaeth o ymyriadau ymarferol a therapiwtig o fewn Fframwaith sy'n Canolbwyntio ar Atebion:

- Gwaith unigol gyda rhieni,
- Gwaith unigol gyda phlant.
- Gwaith grŵp gyda theuluoedd.
- Cynadledau ar gyfer Grwpiau Teuluol (CGT)
- Ymgynghori a dangos y ffordd.
- Cymorth i gael mynediad at wasanaethau cymorth priodol eraill.
- Gweithio cydgysylltiedig amlasiantaethol.

Atgyfeiriadau

Gall unrhyw asiantaeth sy'n gweithio gyda chyn-filwr a/neu eu teuluoedd atgyfeirio.

Mae'n rhaid fod y rhiant/gofalwr wedi cytuno a chydysynio i'r atgyfeiriad.

Families of Veterans Support Service (FVSS)

Barnardo's has received funding from the Covenant Fund to deliver a service to families and children of Veterans who are in need of support. We want to work collaboratively with Service Charities across Wales to ensure we take a joined up approach, and build strong partnerships in order to meet the overlapping needs of Veterans and their families.

FVSS is an early intervention service where our primary focus is the children and family of the veteran. The service aims to enable families to develop practical and useable strategies to respond to the issues and difficulties they are facing and support them in making the changes they would like to make.

Service Criteria

- 1) Families of Veterans within their local community, who are experiencing difficulties and requesting support.
- 2) Children and Families of veterans who are/or at risk of being affected by the Criminal Justice system.

Eligibility Criteria

Family of a Veteran, where the child and/or parent has multiple support needs

The child needs to be under 18yrs and living in Wales.

Child and/or parent/carer that is affected by the veteran being involved in the criminal justice system which may include:

- Being at risk of offending behaviour
- Has been arrested, charged and or convicted of an offence.
- Is serving a custodial sentence

How and what we do

The support provided is unique to each family, based on an assessment of their individual needs.

We use a variety of practical and therapeutic interventions within a Solution Focused Framework, these include:

- Individual work with parents,
- Individual work with children.
- Family group work.
- Family Group Conferences (FGC)
- Consult and signpost.
- Supported access into other appropriate support services.
- Multi-agency joined up working.

Referrals

Any agency working with a veteran and/or their family can refer.

The parent/carer must have agreed and consented to the referral.

Partnership Working

We work in collaboration with statutory and voluntary organisations seeking to address gaps within or complement existing services.
