

Notice of Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians Order
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14
Public Footpath No. 36 In the Community of Connah's Quay

Flintshire County Council has made an Order which will prohibit pedestrians from using that section of Public Footpath No.36 in the Community of Connahs Quay from its junction with Public Footpath No. 20 in the Community of Connahs Quay near Ewloe Castle at NGR 32889 36762 to a point further down the footpath at NGR 32920 36781.

The reason for the closure is for health and safety reasons during a landslip repair.

There is an alternative route available that follows Public Footpath No. 23 in the Community of Connah's Quay at NGR 32889 36762 and then leaves this Public Footpath at NGR 32882 36773 and follows a route to meet up with Public Footpath No. 36 in the Community of Connah's Quay at NGR 32920 36781.

It is anticipated that the Order will come into force on the 8 March 2021, or as soon as possible thereafter. The footpath closure is expected to last for the maximum period of six months until 7 September 2021.
