GRONANT - SETTLEMENT SERVICE AUDIT

Settlement Commentary

Gronant is located at the north western edge of the County adjacent to the boundary with Denbighshire. The main part of the village lies on the south side of the A548 on the lower slopes of the Clwydian Range AONB. A smaller part of the village lies on the northern side of the A548 on flat land comprising the coastal strip. The upper part of the village is well screened by a wooded hillside rising up from the coastal strip and a broad linear ridge. The village is well catered for in terms of facilities and services and benefits from relative close proximity to Prestatyn and services within the town centre including railway station with access to the rest of North Wales. The Gronant Dunes form part of an extensive network of dunes which extends from Prestatyn in Denbighshire to the Point of Ayr at the entrance to the Dee Estuary. These dunes are of national and international importance.

Broadband Provision

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Gronant post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 2.6 - 8.1 mega-bytes per second with most postcodes having a broadband speed of around 4mbps. Accordingly it is to be expected that broadband provision in Gronant is poor. This level of broadband provision will adversely impact the ability of local residents and businesses alike whether in day to day business activities or for accessing online services such as banking, post office services or online shopping.
