Settlement Commentary

Hendre is a fragmented and very loose grouping of development which sits alongside the Mold – Denbigh Road. As can be seen in the attached plan the settlement doesn't have any particular focus for example it doesn't have a service core and the settlement itself is spread out over a kilometre or more. Hendre has a public house but otherwise has no other services to speak of. Residents in the Hendre area are reasonably well served by the Mold – Denbigh Road which offers access to larger settlements including Mold and Denbigh.

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Hendre post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 4.1-6.2 mega-bytes per second. 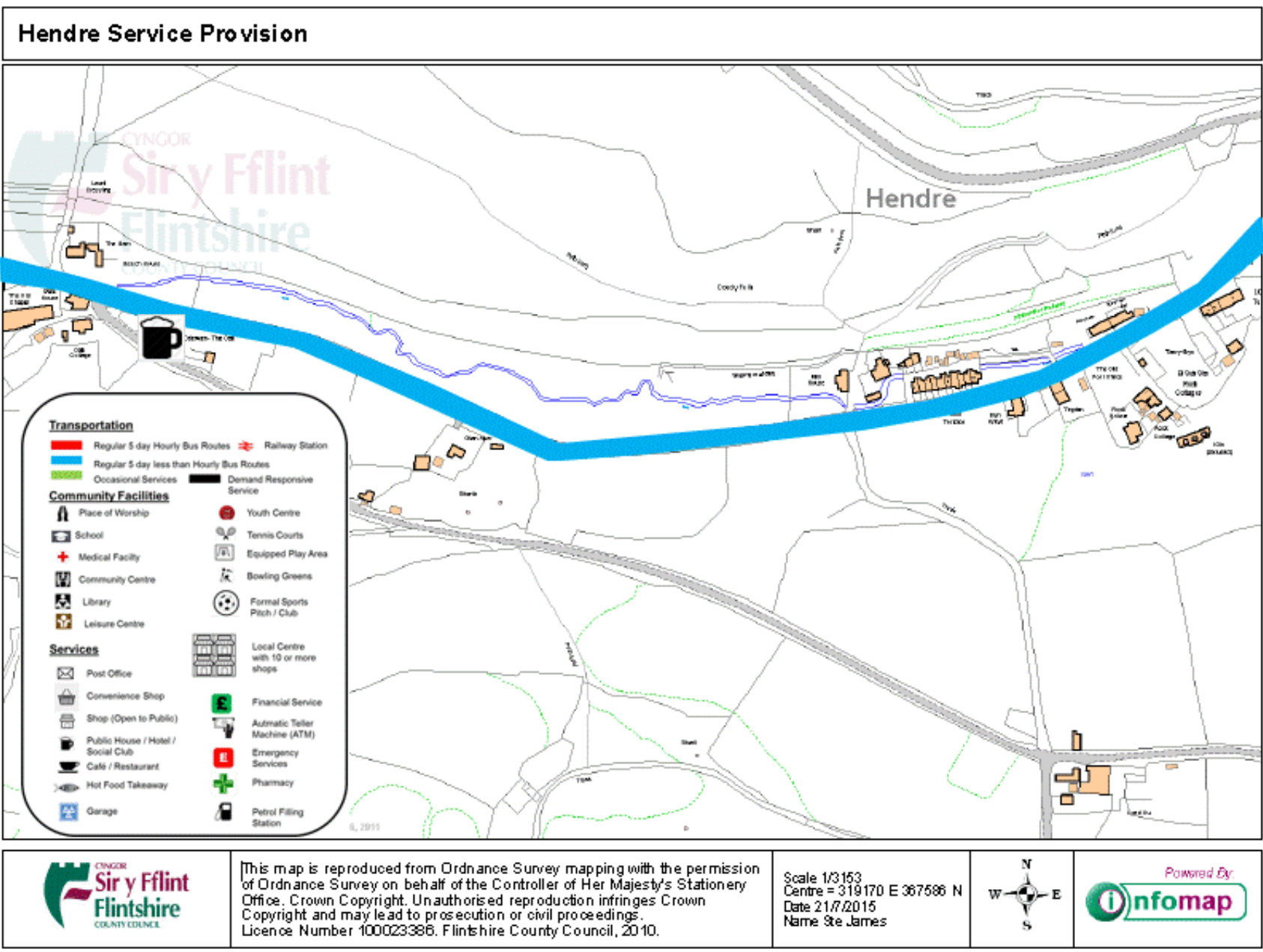
