

## RHEWL MOSTYN - SETTLEMENT SERVICE AUDIT

### Settlement Commentary

Rhewl Mostyn is a settlement in the north-west of the County located close to the banks of the Dee Estuary. The settlement is located close to Glan Y Don and to Maes Pennant (Mostyn) and the Port of Mostyn. The settlement has a poor range of services and facilities. A survey of the village revealed that a number of key buildings have been closed or converted in recent years including the Swan Public House, y Cysegr Chapel, and the Lady Augusta Masonic Hall. Residents within the village are likely to be reliant for day to day services in Glan Y Don and in Maes Pennant whilst having to travel to Holywell or Prestatyn for weekly services such as convenience shopping and banking.

**Broadband Provision**

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Rhewl Mostyn post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 8.1-20.9 mega bytes per second with most postcodes at around 16 mbps. Accordingly it is to be expected that broadband provision in Rhewl Mostyn is good. This level of broadband provision will benefit local residents and businesses alike whether in day to day business activities or for accessing online services such as banking, post office services or online shopping.
