

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE ORDER

The Welsh Government will introduce a national default 20mph speed limit on all restricted roads within Wales from 17th September 2023.

Restricted roads are usually located in residential and built-up areas and have a system of street lighting.

The Authority are reviewing all speed limits within the County, in relation to their suitability to the legislation and the roads within the above list form part of this.

Due to the length of roads contained within this proposed Traffic Regulation Order being in a peripheral area that has no street lighting present for the full extents. Therefore, a 20mph Traffic Regulation Order is proposed, as these roads support the criteria for the suggested advertised speed limit

The Authority continues its responsibility to consider the provision of the convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised to road users as well as improving the amenities of the locality.

The proposals are detailed in the Public Notice and are contained in the proposed Draft Orders.



The Flintshire County Council (Sealand Road, Seahill Road and Old Sealand Road, Sealand) (Speed Limit) Order 2015

Flintshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order
- 4. In this Order except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- The Order shall come into operation on 13 March 2015 and may be cited as the Flintshire County Council (Sealand Road, Seahill Road and Old Sealand Road, Sealand) (Speed Limit) Order 2015.

SCHEDULE 1 Extension of existing 30 mph Speed Limit

Old Sealand Road

From a point 180 metres south east of its junction with Seahill Road for a distance of 38 metres;

SCHEDULE 2 40 mph Speed Limit

Old Sealand Road

From its junction with A548 Sealand Road, to its junction with Seahill Road for a distance of 162 metres;

Seahill Road

From its junction with the Old Sealand Road to the boundary of Flintshire with Cheshire West and Chester a point approximately 266 metres north east of its junction with Elm Tree Road;

SCHEDULE 3 50 mph Speed Limit

A548 Sealand Road

From a point 150 metres east of its junction with Manor Road, in an easterly direction to the boundary of Flintshire with Cheshire West and Chester.
