STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Flintshire County Council are proposing to introduce a Prohibition of Driving restriction on Wrexham Road, Penyffordd. For the purposes of this proposed Order, 'Wrexham Road'– shall mean the service road that runs parallel with the A550 Wrexham Road, Penyffordd.

For some time local concern has been expressed regarding anti-social behaviour occurring in the service road which is affecting the amenity and character of the area.

Therefore, it is proposed to prevent through traffic at this location, but will continue to allow the passage of cyclists and pedestrians.

By implementing this Traffic Regulation Order, it will discourage the anti-social behaviour which is detrimental to the amenity and character of the area whilst also improving road safety.

The proposals are detailed in the Public Notice and are contained in the proposed Draft Order.
