Notice of Proposal to Implement SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR Carriageway Markings at Cornist CP School, Flint, Flintshire

NOTICE is hereby given that Flintshire County Council in exercise of its powers under The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to introduce a 'School Keep Clear' restriction, up to 43 metres in length on FFORDD YR YSGOL, FLINT, on the south-west and south-east side of the carriageway at the entrance to Cornist CP School. Vehicles would be prohibited from stopping on the yellow zig-zag markings indicating the restriction between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Reason for Proposal: Complaints have been received about obstructive parking particularly at school peak times in the area around the entrance to the Cornist CP School. The Council therefore proposes to introduce a No stopping on School Keep Clear marking restriction. The purpose of providing School Keep Clear markings is to keep the space outside of schools free from parked vehicles so that children can be seen more easily when crossing the road.
