

## **Notice of Making**

### **THE FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES – CONNAH’S QUAY) (ADMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2025**

Notice is hereby given that on the 03rd July 2025 Flintshire County Council (“the Council”) have made an Order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (‘the 1984 Act’) and The Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to amend :-

The Flintshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places – Connah’s Quay) (Revocation) Order 2018 and The Flintshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places – Connah’s Quay) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2022

Schedule 2A contained within The Flintshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places – Connah’s Quay) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2022 shall be amended to :-


1. Reflect the reduction in size of the High Street car parking area and a short and long stay provision shall be introduced on the said car park.
2. To regulate the use and set the parking charges in the above parking places.

In all other respects the present provisions of the above Orders will remain in force.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instruments made under it has not been complied with, you may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
