- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. This Order may be cited as the County Council of Flint (Restricted Roads) (No.5) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on the Second day of November 1970.
