Journey Time Savings – Shotton High Street

Scheme background

Flintshire County Council has been successful in obtaining funding from the Welsh Government to improve journey times along Shotton High Street.

In addition to the journey time saving proposals, the Authority are also keen to hear your views on potential cycling measures along Shotton High Street.

Why are improvements required here?

Due to the existing traffic volumes on Flintshire's roads, the Authority needs to develop attractive and alternative modes of transport, as well as improving bus and car journey times. Currently the daily congestion which affects Shotton High Street evidences the need to address the issues faced daily by commuters, residents and businesses.

Proposed Improvements

- Reassessment of current One Way systems
- Revision of right turn provisions
- Road layout formalisation of laybys
- Junction priority measures
- Active travel measures
