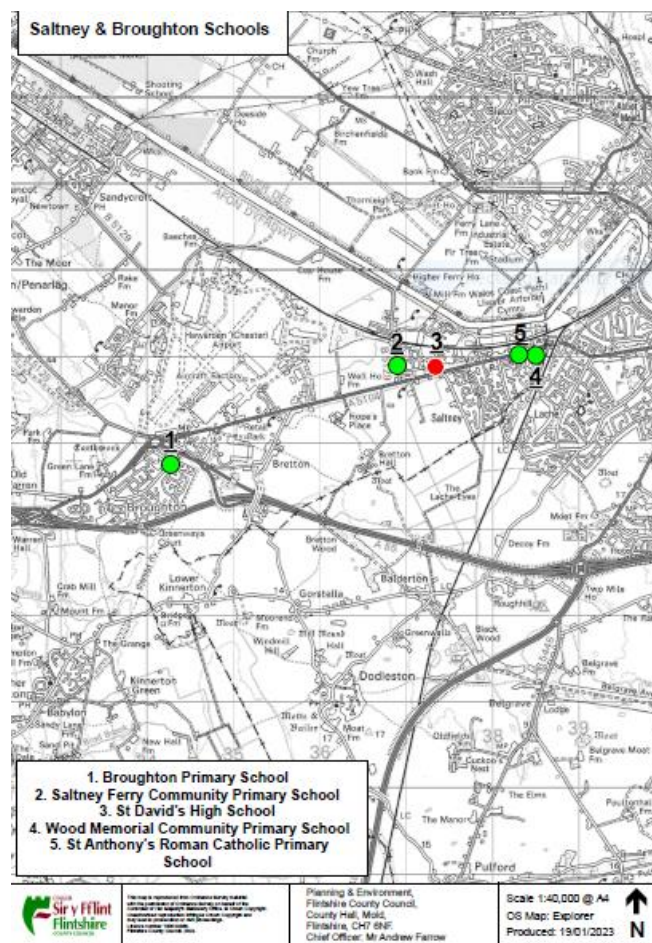

Build a 3 -16 Campus to accommodate St David’s High School and a merged Saltney Ferry CP and Saltney Wood Memorial School, resulting in one high school and one primary school on the same site. *The only land the Council has, which would possibly accommodate this, is in Bretton but this site has several challenges including flood risk, access issues, and is remote from both Broughton and Saltney. The existing St David’s High School site cannot accommodate a 3 – 16 campus due to its size.*

Build a 3 -16 All Through School. St David’s High School merges with Saltney Ferry CP and Saltney Wood Memorial and a new school is created on the same site for all learners in this age range.
