Flintshire County Council is considering changing the way that education is being delivered in your area, by increasing the size of Ysgol Penyffordd to allow additional pupils into the school.


The Council is looking to increase the number of full time pupils at Ysgol Penyffordd from 315 to 375.


What are we doing?


The Council must follow certain processes when considering making significant changes to schools.

As part of these processes we have started a formal discussion to ask for your views to help our decision making process.

Your views are very important to us and will be given to the Council's Cabinet to make a decision to make changes to Ysgol Penyffordd.

Councillors will discuss your views, issues and implications of the options for Ysgol Penyffordd and then will decide what happens next.







Ysgol Penyffordd - Background


There are a number of primary schools and one high school in Penyffordd and surrounding area

- Ysgol Penyffordd is the only English medium community school in the area
- It can currently accommodate up to 315 full time pupils
- In 2019 the Council built a new school for Ysgol Penyffordd on the existing Abbotts Lane Infants site to combine two sites into one
- Increased housing developments and pupils in the area has put pressure on demand for places at Ysgol Penyffordd







Why are we thinking about changing things?

- We would like all children and young people in the local area to attend their local school
- Demand for places at Ysgol Penyffordd has increased and we want to address this by building two additional classroom spaces for the school
- We have additional funding to support investment into Ysgol Penyffordd





What are our options?

We have looked at a number of options for schools in the area


- Option 1 Do nothing this option has been rejected as this would not address the increased demand for pupil places at Ysgol Penyffordd and would mean some pupils in the area would potentially have to travel out of the area for their education ⋈
- Option 3 Increase the size of Ysgol Penyffordd to provide two additional classrooms to allow the school to accept more pupils – this is our preferred option ☑



What are we Proposing?

We are proposing the following

- ❖ Increase the size of Ysgol Penyffordd from 315 to 375 full time pupils.
- Build two additional classrooms built onto the existing school building for Ysgol Penyffordd (one classroom on the ground floor for Foundation Phase and one classroom on the first floor for Key Stage 2)
- We are looking to increase the size of the school and complete the building works by September 2023

Planning Permission = already sought and approved
Predicted Project Costs = £600,000

Stage of Process	Key Dates
Formal Consultation	1 March 2022 to 11 April 2022
Cabinet consider the results of the consultation and determines whether to proceed with proposals	July 2022
Council publish statutory notice and enter into objection period	September 2022
Cabinet consider the objection report and determine whether or not to implement the proposals	November 2022
Decision notification letter is issued with outcome from Cabinet determination	December 2022
